Before you begin your search, here are some facts about faith and worship in Charlotte. Charlotte is home to one of the most loved evangelist, Billy Graham. Rev. Graham was born in Charlotte in 1918. At one time Rev. Graham was known as the “pastor to U.S. presidents”. He died in February 2018 at 99, and is buried on the grounds of Charlotte’s Billy Graham Library. Adjacent to the library is the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, now led by his son Franklin.

Charlotte is also the home of the 1.4-million-member African Methodist Episcopal Zion (A.M.E. Zion) Church. The A.M.E. Zion denomination was founded in the early 1800s.

A road called Providence:

In theology, divine providence, or just providence, is God’s intervention in the Universe. Providence Road is home to many of the city’s most prominent churches. Long known as “The City of Churches,” Charlotte is becoming more diverse.
