

SUPPLY LIST

- **Scissors** (*not included*)
 - » A good sharp pair of scissors that can cut thick paper easily
- **Plain Doormat**
 - » 2' x 1' 4" fiber doormat
- **Black Acrylic Paint**
 - » For coloring in the image
- **Bristle Paintbrush**
 - » Thick bristle for painting the doormat fiber
- **Sewing Pins or Tape** (*not included*)
 - » For holding down the stencil while painting

CUSTOM DOORMAT - 3 EASY STEPS

- **Step One: Cut Your Stencil**

- » Start by cutting out the images and words in your stencil.



- **Step Two: Secure the Stencil**

- » To secure the stencil artwork onto the doormat, place a few sewing pins in various areas. This way when you're dabbing the paint, the stencil will not move around.

- **Step One: Begin to Dab Paint**

- » With your bristle paintbrush, hold it vertically upright and start to **dab paint over the stencil**. Try to avoid brushing, as this won't evenly cover the fibers. If the paint is too thick for dabbing, mix it with a small amount of water. Hold the stencil in place with one hand while dabbing paint with the other. Once you've got enough coverage and letters are bold enough, remove the stencil.
