

do it yourself ribbon wreath

SUPPLY LIST

- Scissors (not included)
 - » A good sharp pair of scissors that can cut ribbon easily

Ribbon

» A selection of ribbon rolls in coordinated colors, and varying patterns, textures and widths

Grosgrain Ribbon

» Six rolls of grosgrain ribbon in different widths, ranging from 5/8" – 1"

Printed Burlap

» One 10-yard roll of 5" wide burlap: cut into two 2.5" wide strips

• Tulle

» Two 10-yard rolls of tulle, 6" wide

Deco Mesh

» One 5-yard roll, 5" wide

• 18" Wire Wreath Form

RIBBON WREATH - 3 EASY STEPS

Step One: Cut Your Ribbon

 » Start by cutting your ribbon into pieces, each about 8 – 10 inches in length

Step Two: Tie the Ribbon

- » Begin by tying ribbon on the **outer ring** of the wire wreath form. You don't need fancy skills. Just a simple loose knot will do. Use one of your wider ribbons on the outer ring.
- » If supplied, you might consider using a solid colored transparent ribbon (*like tulle or deco mesh*), for this outer ring.
- » You should tie 15-20 pieces of ribbon per section to ensure you have good coverage of the wire frame when the wreath is complete.

Step Three: Move Inward

- » Once you have completed the outer ring, move on to the second ring and begin the process again.
- » As you continue on into the inner ring, mix and match your ribbon to make your own unique creation!
