New Home Construction

» *{building from the ground up}*

The traditional Habitat model of building new or renovating existing homes alongside our partner families is at the foundation of what we do. This program empowers homebuyers earning between 30%-80% of the HUD Area Median Income (AMI) to purchase homes with affordable mortgages.

Once approved, Homeowners-in-Process complete several hundred Sweat Equity hours and sixteen weeks of homebuyer education classes. Once all program requirements have been met, the family will close on their new home and begin to experience the life-changing impact of homeownership!

Critical Home Repair

» *{keeping a safe, affordable home intact}*

Critical Home Repair exists to meet the urgent need of preserving the existing affordable housing stock in our community. The program provides homeowners earning under 80% of HUD AMI with significant home repairs, such as extensive roofing, flooring, plumbing, electrical and HVAC repair, as well as accessibility upgrades.

These services are provided at a very reduced rate in order to decrease substandard housing conditions for those with limited financial resources and to allow homeowners to age in place, where they can continue to be an anchor in their neighborhood.

Women Build

What began as a casual conversation in 1991 has grown into an international movement of women empowering women through affordable housing. To date, nearly 3,000 homes have been constructed by all-female crews in the U.S. and 30 foreign countries...and it all started right here in our community! ([May - July](#))

Playhouse Build is a fun and meaningful way to work side-by-side with teams of volunteers in constructing and painting children's playhouses that are then donated to local Habitat families. Sponsorship for this program supports other construction projects throughout our community.

Global Village

Habitat Charlotte Region has tithed nearly \$8 million to sister affiliates overseas, serving over 2,300 families. Each year, Habitat Charlotte Region leads multiple build trips to work with our international partners: Habitat for Humanity El Salvador, Habitat for Humanity Cambodia, and Habitat Guatemala.



Veterans Build

Veterans Build not only provides homeownership opportunities and critical home repairs for veterans, it provides opportunities for military-trained men and women to use their skills in the community. These veterans have served our country faithfully; it is now our privilege to serve them.



Money Matters

Money Matters is an expanded financial literacy curriculum offered to residents of Mecklenburg and Iredell Counties. The three-week program focuses on homeownership in the Charlotte region and assists program participants in their pursuit of homeownership and improved financial well-being.



Neighborhood Revitalization

Through Neighborhood Revitalization, Habitat Charlotte Region partners with neighborhood associations, residents, faith communities, local government and other area nonprofits to develop and implement a shared vision that meets specific needs identified by the community.

The ultimate mission of Neighborhood Revitalization is community-wide change that empowers residents to take ownership and pride in their neighborhood, and to enhance the quality of life for all its residents.
