In October 2023, Habitat Charlotte Region will host the 37th Jimmy & Rosalynn Carter Work Project, activating volunteers from across the U.S. to build 27 homes in one week alongside celebrity ambassadors Garth Brooks and Trisha Yearwood. The homes are part of the \$10.6M Meadows at Plato Price development, which will create affordable homeownership opportunities for 39 families on property that was once home to a school for African American students. As Habitat Charlotte Region recognizes its 40th anniversary, it is honored to host the Carter Work Project for the second time and bring greater awareness to the role of affordable housing in building a legacy of impact in the community. The first Charlotte-based Carter Work Project happened in 1987 and resulted in 14 affordable homes in the Optimist Park neighborhood. Click here to learn more.
